Regulations AFPadel Major Tour 2025



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1. Specific Regulations for the AFPadel Major Tour

The general regulations of AFPadel apply.

All players must be affiliated to the AFPadel federation.

If you don't have an account or a licence for 2025 on our system you need to create one following this tutorial! In case of problem contact us: secretariat@afpadel.be or +32 495/60.77.55.

2.Draws:

2.1 Men (40 pairs max):

Main draw: 16 seeded pairs: 8 pairs placed in the Round of 32 and 8 pairs placed in the Round of 16 + 8 pairs from the qualifiers.

Qualifiers: 24 pairs placed in groups of 3 - 1 pair qualifies per group (in the case of groups of 4, 2 pairs will qualify).

AFPadel has one wildcard for the main draw and two wildcards for the qualifying draw. These wildcards are not mandatory.

2.2 Woman (16 pairs max):

Main draw: 4 seeded pairs placed in the quarter-finals + 4 pairs from the qualifiers.

Qualifiers: 12 pairs placed in groups of 3-1 pair qualifies per group (in the case of groups of 4, 2 pairs will qualify).

AFPadel has one wildcard for the main draw and one wildcard for the qualifying draw. These wildcards are not mandatory.


2.3 Distribution:

The 16 best pairs (for men) or 4 best pairs (for women) are directly placed in the main draw. The qualified pairs (1st in their group) will be placed in the main draw in the Round of 32 (for men) and the quarter-finals (for women) by a random draw (see ANNEX 1).

If there are qualifiers (2nd in group), they will be placed in the draw against the highest seeds by drawing lots.

If the number of registered pairs is less than or equal to 16 (for men) or 8 (for women), all pairs will be placed directly into the final draw. The seeded pairs will be placed in the draw according to the following order (1 to 8 or 1 to 4):





The remaining pairs will be randomly placed in the remaining spots (9 to 16 or 5 to 8).

If a pair is WO in the first round of the final draw, it will be replaced by a lucky-looser (see above for the LL rules).

Schedules are provided for reference only and should be checked for each round.

4. Match format:

All the matches are played in 2 SETS + SUPER TIE-BREAK in case of a third set EXCEPTED the SEMI-FINAL and the FINAL (in Men) and the FINAL (in Woman) who are played in 3 sets

NO GOLDEN POINTS

5. Participation fees:

25€/player



6. Prize Money (per player):

6.1 Men:

Winners : 500€ Finalists : 250€ 1/2 : 100€ 1/4 : 50€

6.2 Women:

Winners : 400€ Finalists : 200€ 1/2 : 75€

No prize money will be awarded in case of unjustified walk-over in the final draw.

In the event that the number of entries is insufficient, the prize money may be adjusted.

7. Streaming:

The finals will be streamed live.

8. Foreign players:

Foreign players (or players from another federation) will be assimilated according to their national ranking by the ranking committee.

They must request this when they apply for their licence by email to the following address: secretariat@afpadel.be.

The organizer reserves the right to modify the tournament format or the organization of the rounds according to the number of registered participants.

9. Regulation regarding qualifying spots for the Final Draw :

Qualified are:

The winners of each group.

As many best second-placed teams from the groups to complete the final draw.

The remaining second-placed teams from the groups are considered 'Lucky Losers'.



Determination of the order of the best second-placed teams from the groups :

The best runner-up from a group is determined as follows:

1. The team that lost the fewest sets in the match against the first-place team in the group (a super tie-break counts as 1 set) is ranked as the best runner-up.

In the event of a tie between multiple teams:

2. If sets do not break the tie, the difference between games won and games lost against the first-place team in the group is considered. (A super tie-break is counted as 7/6 or 6/7).

If one or more teams are still tied:

3. The team that lost the fewest sets across both group matches (super tie-break counts as 1 set) is ranked higher.

If the tie persists:

4. If sets do not break the tie, the difference between games won and games lost across all group matches is considered. (A super tie-break is counted as 7/6 or 6/7).

If the tie still remains:

5. The remaining tied teams will be ranked according to the group they belonged to, meaning the second-place team from Group 1 will be ranked ahead of the second-place team from Group 2, and so on.

If there is a walkover (WO) in a group, the score to be used for calculating the best runner-up is 6/3 6/3.

10. Lucky Loser:

The second-placed teams from their group not included in the final draw are considered 'Lucky Losers' and retain their priority order according to the ranking established in the calculation of the best second-placed teams from the groups. They will only enter the final draw in case of withdrawal by a qualified team or a seeded team, and this only during the first round of the final draw (1/8 of finals for men and ¼ finals for women).


